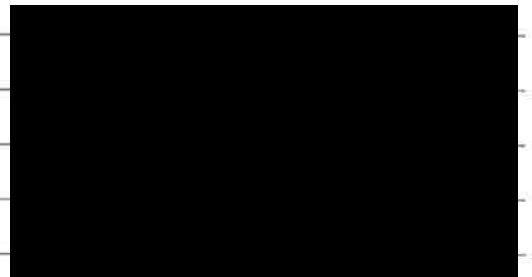


Honourable Dale Wakefield,
