I am a parent of two primary school aged children who attend [REDACTED] Christian School. I am very disturbed to hear that the vision and mission of NT Christian Schools may be impacted with any new changes to the Anti-Discrimination Act. We send our children to a Christian School because we put a high value on our children being taught by Christian teachers, who hold the same beliefs and values as us.

I have the right to send my children to a school where they are taught within a Christian community. It is a school where teachers, students and staff have the freedom to speak freely about their beliefs and teach an authentic Christian curriculum. Our children are taught by passionate teachers who believe in the ethos of the school and model the Christian life to their students.

My [REDACTED] migrated to Australia [REDACTED] When it was time to send their children to school, there was no option other than the local government school. They were the first pioneers of Christian Schools in [REDACTED] and worked tirelessly to establish a school that provided Christian education taught by Christian teachers in a Christian community. This is what I believe in too. I am privileged and thankful that I have the opportunity here in the NT to continue that legacy from my children's [REDACTED] It is my right as a parent to want this and have this.
